



## **2018 Brass Video Audition Requirements**

Performers will need to record their audition and submit the video via “Unlisted” YouTube link(s).

To make an Unlisted Video on YouTube, go to: <https://www.youtube.com/upload>

Note: The box in the middle of the screen that defaults to “Public”, click on that tab and you will see “Unlisted” as an option before you upload your video. Only people with the link will see your video(s) if you choose that option. We will not share your video outside of Spirit of Atlanta. Once the upload is complete, you will copy the link(s) and send those to [brass@spiritdrumcorps.org](mailto:brass@spiritdrumcorps.org) in an email

Make sure the camera angle allows the viewer to see the performer’s entire body, including your feet. Point your horn away from the camera for optimal sound.

Make sure the recording has limited to no additional outside noises.

### What to Include in your Video Audition:

- Perform the Lyrical etude with individually created choreography. This can be a separate video if you choose.
- The Technical etude while marking-time. This can be a separate video if you choose.
- Their full range chromatic scale (Performers choose their top and bottom note) This can be a separate video if you choose.
- The lead trumpet/mellophone etude if they want to be considered for a lead part in those sections. This can be a separate video if you choose.
- None of the etudes need to be memorized.
- You will record yourself performing #3 and #7 from the “On-The-Move” page at mm=140 and 170 while performing a Box 8 drill (Forward 8, left slide 8, backwards 8, right slide 8, Halt).
- There should be an audible metronome on the recording, if at all possible. Consider using a Bluetooth speaker of some type to help with amplifying the metronome.

Once you have completed your recordings and the upload is complete, you will copy the link(s) and send those to [brass@spiritdrumcorps.org](mailto:brass@spiritdrumcorps.org) in an email. Please allow 7-10 days for the completion of the evaluation. We will strive to complete the evaluation sooner.
